Once again, FAIR time is upon us. As usual, we anticipate clear skies and a large, congenial crowd with deep pockets. *Sabena Norman is taking a year off from her long-standing role of vendor coordinator, and I'll be glad to answer your questions prior to the Fair and to meet and help you all on the 28th.*

This year we have many prime spaces available for you to choose from. The spaces have no electricity. PLEASE choose your site carefully. *If you have a favorite spot from the past, please be specific about your location.* We award sites on a first come, first serve basis. The spaces allotted are 10'x 10', and all are outside. This year all the booths will be facing inward toward the church. The FAIR runs from 9am to 4pm. Please DO NOT begin closing up your exhibit before 4pm, no matter how tempting, on the day of the FAIR.

If you have been judged for our fair before and are a returning craftsman, please return this application with the \$50.00 entry fee before July 13, 2007. Please indicate on the application your site preferences, and if you need electricity. REMEMBER, set up is from 6am-8:30am. You are responsible for your complete set up- tables, chairs, extension cords, tents or tarps. We supply the site only! Vehicles must leave the FAIR grounds by 8:15am and during the FAIR. Special parking will be available for you.

Part of the history of our FAIR is that we pride ourselves on actually demonstrating and featuring each craft during the day. If you wish, please enclose a 3x5 card with a brief description of your work and hopefully it will be highlighted over the P.A. system during the fair, We will also have a tent with actual demonstrators and if you would like to demonstrate that would be a bonus for visitors. ** WE HIGHLY DISCOURAGE PRE-BOUGHT, MASS PRODUCED CRAFTS and RESERVE ALL RIGHTS TO TURN YOU AWAY THE DAY OF THE FAIR WITHOUT A REFUND. ** Pre-bought crafts are unfair to those who spend their valuable time making hand-made products.

The money made at this fair is split between the local Canterbury Community Church and the Canterbury Fund which helps Canterbury residents in need.

If you want to be a new participant in our FAIR, please send us photographs and a description of your craft for judging before you fill out your application.
